



Postdoctoral Fellowships at the Psyphas Program in Philosophy and Psychology, The University of Haifa

Psyphas B.A honors program in Philosophy and Psychology at the University of Haifa, invites applications for postdoctoral fellowships for the academic year 2017-18, with a possibility of renewal for a second year. One or two postdoctoral fellowships will be awarded to outstanding young scholars whose research addresses the rich relationship between philosophy and psychology, broadly conceived.

Fellowship recipients will actively participate in the program's activities and will be encouraged to conduct research on the intersection between philosophy and psychology. In addition, they will be asked to teach a one-semester course (2 hours per week). Fellows will receive:

- 1) Fellowship in the amount of NIS 69,000 per year (approx. USD 19,000)
- 2) Teaching fee in accordance with the standard university scale

Candidates must hold a Ph.D in philosophy, psychology, or a related field, and have an active interest in the relations between the disciplines. Ph.D must have been conferred no-earlier than October 2012.

Application to include:

- Curriculum Vitae (including list of publications)
- Two letters of reference
- Description of research proposal for the fellowship period (up to 1000 words)
- Description of two courses, dealing with the relations between philosophy and psychology, broadly conceived, which the candidate would like to teach
- A document confirming award of PhD
- Writing sample
